

Alternative Transportation to Grounds - Fall 2020

UTS

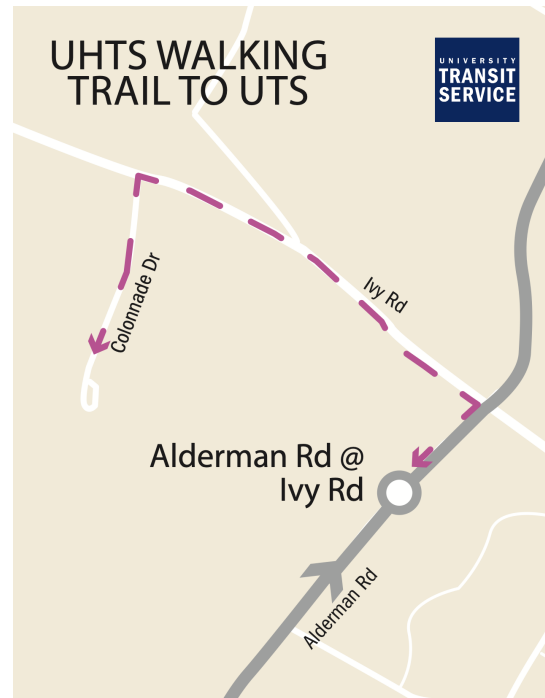
- The Silver Line provides access to Grounds from University Heights via a bus stop on Alderman Rd. just before the intersection with Ivy Rd. The bus stop is reachable via the sidewalk on Ivy Rd (5~7-minute walk).

Safe Ride

- Safe Ride is an on-demand, point-to-point van shuttle provided after UTS has stopped service for the night. For Fall 2020, it is operation from 10pm to 7:30am, Monday-Sunday. A ride can be requested via the TransLoc app or by calling (434) 242-1122, and a valid UVA ID is required to board.

DART

- Demand and Response Transportation (DART) provides transportation to people who are unable to use fixed-route bus service due to a disability. DART operates when UTS is in service and individuals must be approved prior to using DART. Please visit the P&T website at <https://parking.virginia.edu/dart> for more information.



Bike, Scooters, and Mopeds

- Everyone is encouraged to use personal, alternative transportation devices to get to and around Grounds, especially given the limited seating capacity on UTS buses due to COVID-19. Such devices include bicycles, scooters, and mopeds for which UVA offers parking across Grounds.
